In the event of an incident involving physical aggression, discrimination, harassment or verbal abuse:

- The offending individual will be asked to leave the event and/or facility.
- If the offender refuses to leave, the Lee County Sheriff will be called.
- Additionally, each reported incident will be reviewed and could result in the Master Board seeking a No Trespass Order against the offending individual.
- RV Park residents will risk being asked to leave, forfeiting future reservations and contract renewals.
